CEPA advised the Ministry of Agriculture on the potential for private sector participation in setting research priorities and R&D within the new National Agricultural Research System (NARS). The CEPA team met with private agricultural companies, international organisations and government representatives from agricultural and marketing boards to discuss the opportunities and constraints to private sector involvement in national agricultural research.

The deliverable for the work was a presentation to the NARS team, including recommendations on the areas with potential for private sector involvement and structures for such partnerships.
