

A Picture of Health for Bromley, Bexley, Greenwich & Lewisham - Reconfiguration of Services

CEPA is providing comprehensive financial and capacity modeling support to a number of NHS Trusts and PCTs in SE London, as part of a major health service redesign project to improve local NHS services and restore financial balance in the local health economy.

The work has been carried out over a number of phases, with the first of these seeing CEPA focus on reviewing existing material and detailed financial models prepared for the project previously and suggesting ways in which these could be improved. Following this initial review, the CEPA team developed a number of detailed activity and income models to support the modeling of various service reconfiguration scenarios and their impacts on the financial position of individual hospital trusts and the local health economy as a whole. This in-depth analytical work was undertaken in close cooperation with a whole range of sector stakeholders, and supported the preparation of a pre-consultation business case for approval by NHS London (the Strategic Health Authority for London,) prior to a wide ranging public consultation exercise on proposals for improving the provision of health services in the four London boroughs, which is taking place from January to April 2008.
