

A user guide for accessing infrastructure project preparation facilities in Africa

CEPA was commissioned by for the Infrastructure Consortium for Africa (ICA), based at the African Development Bank, and the Public-Private Infrastructure Advisory Facility to help them map out the currently existing donor facilities which provide support to the 'project preparation' activities in infrastructure sectors in Africa. Such activities could range from strengthening the enabling environment (e.g. legislative and regulatory reform), through project design and development (e.g. feasibility / environmental impact studies) to transacting the projects and possibly providing post implementation support.

The outcome of this work was a user guide, which is expected to act as an important reference point for stakeholders working in infrastructure development in Africa. CEPA's work included structuring the guide, conducting extensive research on existing donor facilities, liaising with facility and donor representatives and compiling the information into a user friendly format.
