

Assessing the impact of a proposal to change the rules for transmission network access

CEPA was commissioned by the BWEA to consider the potential impacts of a proposal to amend the existing arrangements for allocating capacity on the transmission network to promote the development of renewable generation.

CEPA's assessment considered, amongst other things, the volumes of generation that might be able to take advantage of the proposed agreements, the impact on transmission network costs and energy market competition and the associated carbon savings.
