

## **Capex Review of Dublin Airport**

CEPA was retained by CAR to undertake a review of the capex incentives acting upon the Dublin Airport Authority and provide advice on how to strengthen the regulatory incentive framework (including development of new incentives mechanisms) so as to promote the timely and efficient delivery of capex.

In particular, areas looked to improve the investment incentive framework included: a review of historical incentives and their effectiveness; management incentive plans; a menu of options approach to investment; airline involvement in investment decisions; capex triggers; and congestion charging.
