

Title: Development of an infrastructure PPP compendium for the Commonwealth Secretariat

CEPA is currently developing a compendium on infrastructure PPPs for the Commonwealth Secretariat. The Compendium aims to be a comprehensive reference manual for Ministers and senior decision makers covering policy and design issues relating to PPPs. The key aspects to be covered by the Compendium include: trends in PPP theory and practise; constraints to infrastructure PPPs in developing countries and measures to address these constraints – including PPP units, donor funded facilities, amongst others; the infrastructure project cycle and the project development process; and PPP portfolio management. The Compendium will also include detailed case studies on successful and failed PPP transactions across the infrastructure sectors (including social infrastructure) to bring out the main lessons that can be derived.

The Compendium is being developed through extensive desk research as well as selective consultations with Governments in the Commonwealth countries to solicit their views on the kinds of information they would find useful in such a guide.
