

Advice on Regulatory Price Issues for Czech Water

As part of a consortium working for the Ministry of the Environment, CEPA is providing specialist inputs on regulatory price issues. To meet EU concerns about the sustainability of investments into the water and sewerage sector in the Czech Republic, the Ministry of the Environment hired a consortium to prepare a new price regime to apply for the public-private partnerships receiving EU grant funding. CEPA has provided advice on all aspects of the pricing regime as well as providing high-level inputs to the design of the appropriate financial model supporting the new regime. Advice on an appropriate cost of capital as well as whether a margin on costs based approach could be used has also been given.
