

Title: Development of a Framework for analysing land access issues in agricultural development projects

CEPA worked with IIED (a London based research organization) on the development of a framework for identifying, understanding and addressing land access issues in the BMGF's agricultural development grants. CEPA provided strategic advice on the development an M&E process (to be implemented by BMGF Program Officers and grantees) for identifying possible negative 'unintended consequences' of the grants BMGF supports (the principle potential unintended consequence of an agricultural development grant is smallholder loss of access to land following increases in land values and competition due to BMGF intervention). CEPA worked with IIED consultants to deliver a slide document containing a conceptual and operational frameworks, case study analyses of BMGF grants, and a set of land access learning materials for Program Officers and grantees.
