The Irish Commission for Energy Regulation is in the process of developing a scheme to regulate the activities of electricity and gas contractors with the aim of improving the overall level of safety within the Irish marketplace.

CEPA was commissioned to consider alternative approaches to the economic regulation of the scheme. In particular CEPA considered the incentives created by the not for profit nature of the safety supervisory bodies and the interaction between the process of appointing these bodies and the appropriate method of economic regulation.
