

Feasibility and establishment of InfraCo Asia (previously known as the Asian Private Infrastructure Financing Facility (AsPIFF))

Date: 2005 – ongoing

CEPA has been awarded the contract to carry out the feasibility and implementation for InfraCo Asia for the PIDG group of donors.

In the first stage of the project, CEPA carried out due diligence on the market need, market dimension, sponsor characteristics, extent of the financing gap in pro-poor infrastructure projects in Asia, and the most appropriate financing concept. In the second stage, CEPA worked on the definition of the facility itself, including its size, likely funding sources, lending criteria, credit and risk assessment, portfolio classification and management, disclosure rules, governance, administrative and control aspects, location and management. Following this, CEPA's work in the third stage is focused on the identification of a pipeline of projects and on the formal establishment of the facility, including support with the engagement of a suitably qualified management company to run the facility on behalf of the investors.
