

A Picture of Health for South East London - Reconfiguration of Services

A Picture of Health for South East London is a major service redesign and sustainability project to identify opportunities to improve the configuration of clinical services within the local health economy, with the objective of improving patient care, reducing waste and increasing efficiency.

The work was carried out over a number of phases, with the first of these seeing CEPA focus on reviewing existing material and detailed financial models prepared for the project previously and suggesting ways in which these could be improved. Following this initial review, the CEPA team developed a number of detailed activity, income and cost models to support the modelling of various service reconfiguration scenarios and their impacts on the financial position of individual hospital trusts and the local health economy as a whole. This in-depth analytical work was undertaken in close cooperation with a whole range of sector stakeholders, and had as one of its aims to prepare the ground for a wide ranging public consultation exercise on the future of health care provision in South-East London.
