

Severn Trent: Regulatory regime for the next periodic review of the water sector

Working with Indepen we are developing options for Severn Trent to propose to Ofwat to develop the regulatory regime for the next periodic review of the water sector. This includes considering regime options that have worked well in other sectors and considering whether they would improve the regulatory regime in the water sector. The project also seeks to engage a range of stakeholders to get their views on the options being considered. A second phase of the project focuses on developing a small number of options in much greater detail. CEPA's second report for Severn Trent will propose detailed implementation plans for reforms to the water sector and evaluate their potential impact using information from previous periodic reviews and outturn expenditure information.
